ANNUAL REPORT 2009

Dear Friends of the Kitchens and Pantry,

Thank you for spending time with us to appreciate our calling – since 1976 – to serve the hungry as well as to recognize our wonderful partners and to understand the business aspects of our work.

2009 In Review - We continued to see demand increase by an additional 8% more meals and 6% more bags of groceries this year, even after the huge demand spurt in 2008 (21% more meals and 35% more bags of groceries). With your support, we met the demands of serving daily hot meals and distributing groceries every Tuesday and Thursday at the Pantry. **This year we served over 180,500 meals and distributed groceries to nearly 12,000 individuals and families.** As the weak economy sent many more people to our doors, we faced much greater expenditures for food and much less funding from grant makers. Thankfully, our donors were able and willing to be more generous this year. This allowed us to nearly maintain our support levels. In 2010, we will focus on maintaining donations and increasing grant support to make ends meet without having to deplete our basic reserves and without increasing our ultra low fundraising costs.

Each day, we are reminded by our guests that they rely on and truly appreciate our services. The population we serve consists of people who are disadvantaged by their physical or mental health or other circumstances. They lack the financial means, the psychological capacity, the housing, or even life skills to provide themselves with a daily meal and/or groceries. Among our guests, we see the working poor, the mentally ill, the elderly poor, and those who are homeless. We seek to meet their basic human needs for food and water, thereby improving their quality of life.

In 2009, our network of loyal volunteers, supportive organizations, and individuals provided critical donations of food, supplies, and labor. Details of these accomplishments follow in the *Highlights*. Join us in celebrating each one!

We are grateful for the opportunity to look back at the year and give heartfelt thanks to our volunteers, donors, employees, and Board of Directors for their commitment to care for the poor. Just as we rely on you daily, our guests rely on us.

- In 2009, substantive construction work was completed for the new offices and flexible meeting space at the Walnut Hills Kitchen and Pantry. Flooring and painting remain to be completed in 2010. We thank volunteers from General Electric, MI & ES Aviation, who have volunteered their time, materials, and labor in completing this three year endeavor and especially thank project manager Dave Yates, who integrates the volunteers and work. General Electric volunteers have participated in many ways with the Kitchens and Pantry. Completion of this key project will allow us for the first time to have training space, a meeting room, and the key business offices consolidated under one roof.
- David Angevine retired August 27 after five years of service managing the Over-The-Rhine Kitchen. Patricia Wakim stepped in as Interim Manager until a replacement can be hired and trained.
- Melody Byrom, Manager of the Walnut Hills Kitchen and Walnut Hills Pantry, continues to manage both facilities, as well as coordinate volunteer activity, communicate with food/supply donors, and solicit new food/supply donations. Melody also provided weekend support at the Over-The-Rhine Kitchen until the manager position could be filled.
- November 18, William "Mr. Bill" Kenny, our highest seniority volunteer, celebrated his 96<sup>th</sup> birthday and 33 uninterrupted years with Over-The-Rhine Kitchen! His story and live interview was televised by Channel 5, WLWT News (<http://www.wlwt.com/video/21623853/index.html>).



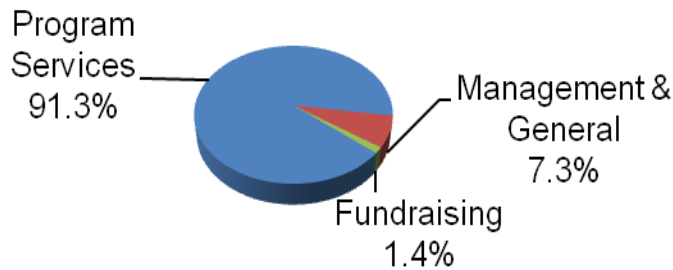

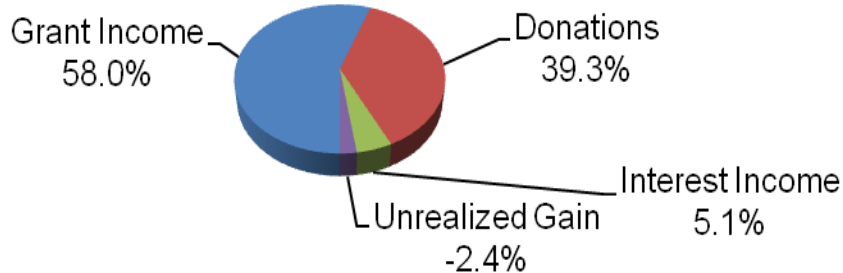

**Overview**

The weak economy sent many more people to our doors, requiring greater expenditures for food. A bit of this cost increase was offset by our OTR Kitchen Manager retiring and not being replaced immediately, so salary costs dipped temporarily in 2009. Fundraising continued to be kept ultra low. Grant funding was difficult to obtain due to the tight economy. Thankfully, our donors were able and willing to be more generous this year. This allowed us to nearly maintain our support level from 2008. In 2010, we hope to maintain donations and increase grant support to make ends meet without depleting basic reserves or increasing fundraising costs.
